

## WHAT IS PLASMA FIBROBLAST THERAPY

Plasma Fibroblast Therapy targets fibroblasts. These are the collagen<sup>1</sup> and protein-producing cells in the dermis, the layer of skin just below your outermost skin layer.

Fibroblasts play an important role in helping skin wounds heal as well as maintaining skin firmness and tightness.

We use a PureBeau Fibroblast System to discharge high-frequency electric current to small areas of the skin. The plasma tip doesn't directly touch the skin, but instead releases a targeted current just above the skin. The hot current creates small holes, or micro-injuries, in the skin's layer.



The thermal disruption, or heat damage, from plasma fibroblast therapy breaks down proteins in the skin that:

- Encourages tissue regeneration
- stimulates fibroblast activity
- causes tissue contraction (tightening)

<sup>1</sup> Collagen is the most common protein found in the body. It's present in tendons, fat, and ligaments, among other places. It helps the pieces of our bodies to fit together, and is crucial to the structure of our skin. When collagen levels are healthy, cells that contain collagen take on a strong and youthful appearance.

The interesting thing about collagen is that stimulating its growth causes a domino effect. The more collagen you have, the more your body is able to produce and maintain.

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

## BENEFITS PLASMA FIBROBLAST THERAPY

Plasma fibroblast therapy is a nonsurgical and affordable treatments that we can use to treat for following conditions:

- acne scars
- photo aging, including age spots
- seborrheic keratosis
- wrinkled skin, including the eyelids, neck, jawline, and above the lips

We also use plasma fibroblast therapy as an alternative to lip fillers to make the lips look fuller.



### Plasma Fibroblast Therapy:

- improve the skins texture
- offers mild-to-moderate skin tightening
- can be used in skin facial contour changes
- is a great solution for non-surgical eye lifts
- is used extensively to minimise crows feet and frown lines
- is excellent for tightening facial features, neck, jaw and stomach
- delivers long lasting improved external skin appearance after the first procedure. The rejuvenated skin condition can last up to 2 years. Also, clients can expect to look and feel ten to fifteen years younger.

## PLASMA FIBROBLAST THERAPY PROCEDURE

While the procedure may vary slightly based on what is being treated the basic steps typically include:

- Cleansing the skin and applying a topical anaesthetic (numbing) cream. You may need to wait about 30 minutes for the numbing cream to take effect.
- Treating the designated skin area with the plasma pen. The pen will create small arcs of micro-currents that make small scab-like dots on the skin.
- The therapist will remove the numbing cream and apply a cooling gel to minimise the tingling and burning sensation whenever possible.

The procedure usually takes about 30 to 60 minutes to perform and depending on the area being treated 1 to 3 sessions will be required..

### Recovery

Once the procedure is completed, you can expect the small dots to scab over and fall off after about 1 week.

Over the next couple of weeks, as your skin heals, it should appear tighter and firmer.




## IS PLASMA FIBROBLAST FOR YOU?

The best candidates for this procedure are people with mild-to-moderate skin wrinkling concerns.

You shouldn't receive plasma fibroblast therapy if you:

- are breast-feeding
- are pregnant
- have an allergy to topical anaesthetic preparations
- have an infection at the treatment site
- are using isotretinoin for wrinkles or acne

In addition, if you have a history of keloids or hypertrophic scarring, it's recommended that you approach plasma fibroblast therapy with caution.



If you are at all uncertain it is important to talk to your health-care provider prior to undertaking this procedure..

It's very important that we establish realistic goals with you. While plasma fibroblast therapy can offer results,

In addition, the procedure isn't without side effects, these can include:

- redness
- swelling
- mild hypo pigmentation (light spots)
- mild hyper pigmentation (dark spots)
- skin peeling and crusting
